Millbrook members will have the rare opportunity to view such memorials, such as letters from John Hancock, General George Washington and President John Adams.

Dr. Soiferman will show and discuss these and other unique, historically significant manuscripts and papers from his collection that offer insights into our country’s founding. **A highlight for Hatboro-area residents includes correspondence between Generals Washington and Lacey on the Battle of Crooked Billet!**
